Welder strikes gold

Despite burning his hand quite badly on the second day of a three-day competition, welder Josh Peek soldered on to become the best in Europe.



The 20-year-old from Norwich was awarded a gold medal at the **EuroSkills Finals in Gothenburg** [↗](#), in front of a crowd of 10,000 at the closing ceremony in the Swedish city yesterday.

More than 500 competitors from 28 nations across the continent were competing in a range of disciplines from beauty to bricklaying, cooking to carpentry, plumbing, plastering and web design.

Josh, who aims to have a quiet Christmas, will then get back into training and hopes to

be selected for the WorldSkills International Finals next October in Abu Dhabi.
